### PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

BioClean is Forterra's newest line of environmental products for stormwater treatment. Products range from large object filtration to fine filtration including bio-filtration. Products such as the Watergate are used on existing or new curb inlet structures and block large solids from entering the stormwater collection system. The Modular Connector Pipe Screen (CPS) covers outflows in junction boxes and manholes to prevent large solids from clogging stormwater collection systems. The SciClone is a hydrodynamic separator, which allows suspended solids to fall out of suspension and reduce Total Suspended Solids (TSS) in stormwater flows, increasing water quality. For finer filtration needs, the Modular Wetland uses both large and fine filtration methods including bio-filtration within one unit. The Modular Wetland received Texas Commission of Environmental Quality (TCEQ) approval for use in the Edward's Aquifer, a large artesian aquifer in western Texas, and provides more treatment capacity in a smaller area.
