Award-winning golf course architect Ron Garl preserved the character of the original Lakewood Golf Club course, while upgrading the 18-hole, 7,002 yards, par 72 course with modernized fairways, tee boxes and greens - new improvements to an old favorite. The course features a fleur de lis-shaped bunker on No. 1, a Maltese Cross-shaped bunker on No. 8, a peninsula green on the par 3, 17th and three sets of flame-shaped bunkers flush with red sand on the finishing hole. Lakewood's history of hosting PGA Tour events, coupled with its beautiful redesign in 2008, make it an exciting venue for golf.
